

Call for Student Volunteers

Participation in the 21st IEEE International Requirements Engineering Conference (RE'13) is a great opportunity for students to get in touch with the latest advances in the field of requirements engineering, and to meet and talk with leading academics, and industrial researchers and practitioners. Being engaged in the **Student Volunteer program** is also an excellent way of meeting other students from all over the world and to offset some of the costs of attending the RE conference. The success of the past RE conferences greatly depended on the lively participation of the student volunteers; their contribution shall also be critical to the success of RE'13.

Benefits of Being a Student Volunteer

- Free conference registration.
- Free admission to tutorials (space permitting).
- Conference proceedings.
- Admission to coffee breaks.
- Admission to the conference banquet.

Requirements & Responsibilities

- Student volunteers must be enrolled in a Ph.D., Masters, or full-time undergraduate program at the time of the conference. They have to be able to communicate well in English.
- Student volunteers are expected to be present during the entire week of July 15th 19th, 2013 and to work about 15 24 hours during this week.
- Student volunteers typically assist with: sessions, panels, and posters; manning the registration desk and checking badges for entry to events; and any other activities that keep the RE conference running smoothly.
- Some student volunteers will also be needed the day before the conference starts for preparation work (Sunday July 14th, 2013).

Application Instructions

To apply for a student volunteer position, you must submit ALL of the following material by email to the Student Volunteers Chair (rguizzardi@inf.ufes.br) by May 24th, 2013:

- A completed student volunteer application form (http://www.cin.ufpe.br/~re2013/files/StudentVolunteerForm RE2013.txt), with an attached Curriculum Vitae (CV) in PDF format. The e-mail should have the subject "RE13-Student-Volunteer-Application" and your last name.
- A letter of recommendation from your academic advisor. Please note that this letter should be in PDF format and MUST originate from the e-mail you indicated for your advisor on your application form. This letter should include your name and confirm the program that you are enrolled in. It should also cover your organizational ability, English proficiency, and willingness to help others. The e-mail should have the subject "RE13-Student-Volunteer-Recommendation" and your last name.
